R eserved Accessible Parking Street Signs Request

A residential reserved parking signs are signs that designate a parking space as “accessible” and only useable by a person who holds the relevant residential disability parking permit. If there is more than one individual in a given area with a disability parking placard, both individuals have equal access to the parking space. It cannot be reserved for a singular individual.

Eligibility Requirements:

You must meet the following eligibility requirements to request a residential parking sign in front of your home:

1. You must be a resident of the Town of Cumberland
2. You must have a valid disability parking placard; AND
3. You must live in either:
 - a. A multi-family building.
 - b. A single-family home with no driveway or off-street parking at all.
 - c. A single-family home and your driveway causes a true hardship to use for parking.
